- VII. Biographical note: founded as a voluntary group of preservationists, the
New Haven Preservation Trust was incorporated on August 7, 1961; the
first meeting of its directors took place on January 29, 1962.

Margaret C.H. Flint (1899-1977), Mrs. Richard Foster, was among the founders of the Trust and served as its Executive Vice-president for several years. These early records of the Trust were kept by her, then by Elizabeth Mills Brown, until they were donated to the Whitney Library. The restricted material refers to controversial issues.
