## Introduction

The United Way was originally incorporated as the Community Chest in 1920. The purpose of the organization, which has not changed, is to raise money for charitable purposes and to distribute the funds either directly or to other agencies.

The organization was changed to the United Fund of Greater New Haven in 1951.

In 1971, the United Fund merged with the Community Council of Greater New Haven and the name was again changed to The United Way.
