## Introduction

Oliver Nettleton was born on March 3, 1787 in Milford, the son of John and Comfort (Hine) Nettleton. He married Sarah Treat on September 8, 1813. They had six children. Sarah was the daughter of Samuel and Sarah (Nettleton) Treat, a direct descendant of Governor Robert Treat, the 8<sup>th</sup> Governor of the Colony of Connecticut. Oliver was a farmer who lived in Milford, Bethany, and Westville at various times in his life. He died on January 31, 1864 and is buried in the Westville Cemetery.
