The papers of the Mix and Munson families were donated to the Whitney Library December 24, 1991 by Ronald Munson.

This collection consists primarily of the voluminous diaries of two sisters, Sarah (Sadie) Mix Munson and Laura Augusta Mix, daughters of Dwight Walter and Elizabeth Bradley Mix who lived in the Hamden Plains district of Hamden, CT. Sarah married Leonard W. Munson also of Hamden and they had one son, Leslie Winship Munson. Laura Augusta Mix was unmarried. The sisters were both quite active in the Hamden Plains Methodist Church. The collection consists of two boxes which contain 61 diary volumes and some family memorabilia.
