Introduction

Vision for a Greater New Haven was organized in 1994 and established a number of Citizen Action Groups to consider problems facing the area.

One of these groups was the Transportation Citizen Action Group (TRANSCAG). The goal of this group was to study the ideas for transportation improvements generated by previous Vision meetings. The following goal was developed and adopted by the Action Group: “A reliable, affordable, efficient, regional transportation system that deemphasizes cars and emphasizes mass transit and non-motorized transportation.”
