He kept account books for stores in Clinton and Lyons, and for carpentry work in New Haven. In the account book referenced below, 5/1/99, George Post indicated he bought an interest in the business from John H. Tilson after whom the company was named.
- VIII. Analysis: The collection consists of 14 ledgers and school notebooks of George H. Post that are contained in 2 boxes arranged as follows: one to two volumes per folder.

Payment for an ad for J.H. Tilson & Co. is noted, 7/22/98, in George H. Post's account book, which constitutes Folder D in Box II. The ad for this stair building company at 82 Water Street appears in the New Haven Directory. v. LIX, 1898, on p. 1014.
